Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about a new provision in Michigan State Law that may impact your child's education during the 2024-2025 school year. According to the newly enacted MCL 388.1621f(14), school districts now have the ability to utilize virtual instruction for up to 15 days within a school year under specific circumstances.

This flexibility allows school districts to continue delivering quality instruction in the event of emergency closures, during student testing days, and for professional development (PD) purposes. The goal is to ensure that educational requirements are met and students' learning progress is not disrupted, even when in-person instruction may not be feasible.

We believe this provision will offer the necessary flexibility to meet the challenges of the school year, ensuring that your child's education remains uninterrupted, no matter the circumstance. We will keep you updated on any specific details or changes regarding virtual instruction days as they arise.

Please ensure your child has a Chromebook. If not, one can be obtained from the Technology Department in preparation for any upcoming virtual instruction days. Chromebooks are available for pickup at the south side basement entrance of the Hamtramck Community Center. You must be 18 or older and present a valid photo ID to sign out a Chromebook for your student.
