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### School Annual Education Report (AER) Kosciuszko Middle School

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Kosciuszko Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been assigned the status of Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI).

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. Students are assigned to schools within the District geographically, however parents are permitted to request placement at other schools within the district
- 2. The 3-5 year MiCIP plan is being revised under the support from Wayne RESA and District Officials

- 3. Kosciuszko is not a specialized school
- 4. The core curriculum is aligned to the state model and can be accessed on the district website (www.hamtramckschools.org) or in hard copy at the main office of the school. Teachers have a copy of the curriculum and their instructional delivery in the classroom is aligned
- 5. Fall iReady Reading data shows 87 students (35%) three or more grade levels below, 78 students (31%) two grade levels below, 76 students (30%) one grade level below, 10 students (4%) on grade level. Fall iReady Math data shows 71 students (28%) three or more grade levels below, 69 students (28%) two grade levels below, 102 students (41%) one grade level below, and 8 students (3%) on grade level.
- 6. Parent-teacher conferences have always been a proud point of collaboration between school and home for Kosciuszko Middle School. 89% of parents actively attended conferences.

Hamtramck Public Schools continues to implement a rigorous curriculum and challenging educational programs that will prepare your child to be successful in the future. 
